
Site Plan Showing location of Contorted Willow T1 and email from Neighbour

My Grade 2 listed wall also has ominous cracks


See below the photos I took recently after doing some pruning on the wall. Also other photos of plinth and tree overhang.


The contorted willow also takes a lot of light from my garden. It was obviously not a wise choice for such a small planting space right next to my wall.





Dear Nick Bell,

Hadiza Mohammed suggested that I contact you about this.

The garden wall of 6 Primrose Hill Studios where I live, is being affected by the now very large contorted willow tree in question.

It was planted not many years ago, by the then owner on the Fitzroy Yard side.

Primrose Hill Studios and it's surrounding walls are Grade 2 listed and the wall is in danger! My garden is at a lower level than the ground on the other side so the roots are pushing at the bottom part of the wall and the trunk itself is pushing the plinth at the top.

I have seen how big these trees can get!

What can I do to get the preservation order overturned?
