This would be required as you did not initially acquire consent for these particular works. However, I've had chat with my managers – in order to simplify this complex matter (in-line with my advice dated 30.08.23) and particularly in regard to Nathan's concerns [see below schedule 2], please re-submit the form (and pay the difference if there is one) so that the proposed works (including the air intake fan) will be assessed through a SEPARATE planning application.
