As a long-time resident of Wesleyan Place, I am shocked by the egregious and cavalier attitude of the owners of The Village Cafe to our immediate neighbourhood as shown by this planning application. <i>i</i>. The proposed addition of both a second floor and a balcony to the building is completely out of character with the existing parade of shops and would contravene the principles of our local Conservation Area. <i>i</i> am also very concerned that we will all be subject to food smells as I can see no effective ventilation proposed. <i>i</i> If such a dominating construction, which took up every inch of available space in a dense urban setting were to be approved, where would the waste storage go?
