## **Assessment**

The s.211 notification is for the removal of a cherry tree from the rear garden of a residential property that is situated within the Primrose Hill Conservation Area.

The small, young cherry tree is of low visibility from the public realm. The tree is not considered to significantly contribute to the character and appearance of the conservation area.

The tree is not considered to be a noteworthy example of its species and is not of a rare species. The tree is of no known cultural or historical significance.

The tree is in extreme close proximity to structures and is not afforded the space it requires to acheive its potential.

Justification for the proposed works is not a validation requirement of s.211 notifications.

Consultation letters were sent to properties at 15, 16 and 17 Chalcot Road and 2 Egbert Street.

The council does not object to the proposed works.
