

I wish to raise an objection to this application. I feel it is anachronistic: too modern and bland for the style of building. The expanse of flush plate 'privacy' glazing brought forward without rebating will be visually intrusive in the line of buildings especially with the contrasting dark painted thick framing. It is also geometrically unrelated and unbalanced with the proportions of the fenestration and elements above.

It requires redesigning and dividing up with glazing bars or other elements.

The existing glazing whilst also poor quality is far less intrusive.
