As a resident of Betterton Street I am writing to submit my objection based on the following:

## Serving hatch

This has been added with no planning permission and put into a door that was never used and previously covered with a roller shutter.

When people are queuing the space within the depth of the railings can hold one person, any more and the customers have to queue on the narrow pavement blocking it for pedestrians who then have to walk in the road to pass – (please see the attached supporting image, I have blanked out the faces for privacy).

It is causing a noise and rubbish nuisance, people don't just move off once they have purchased, they stand around eating and drinking with some dropping litter.

It also has the potential to increase anti-social behaviour within the area with people hanging around asking for money as people queue.

## Lighting
