- 1 x Fraxinus excelsior (T17) Lift crown to 4m.
- 1 x Populus nigra 'Italica' (T16) Crown reduction by 25%, 6m.
- 1 x Betula pendula (T20) Fell to ground level.
- 1 x Quercus rubra (T18) Lift crown to 4m.
- 1 x Betula pendula (T29) Fell to ground level.
- 1 x Acer pseudoplatanus (T37) Fell to ground level.
- 1 x Carpinus betulus (T44) Lift crown to 3.5m.
- 1 x Populus tremula (T48) Reduce crown by 30%, 3m.
