The size, nature and proximity of the tree has caused problems for the adjacent property (47 Dartmouth Park Hill) for some years. It is causing the party wall to crack - this in part because the garden level at No. 49 Dartmouth Park Hill is higher than that at No. 47. The light-blocking mass of the tree affects both our security lighting on that wall (causing it to come on during the daytime) and limits the availability of daylight within the lower flats at No. 47.
