1 Reasons for approval-

The Biodiversity Management Plan describes how new urban habitats will be created (and subsequently, how existing trees will be protected), suitable planting will be provided to enhance biodiversity, and the introduction of

bird/bat boxes and other ecological measures such as bee bricks to encourage new species. The six bird boxes are fixed to only existing mature trees and to the east façade of plot 6, facing the nature reserve area. The birdboxes are made of a woodcrete product with four bat boxes on the south elevation. The council's Nature Conservation Officer has reviewed the details and confirmed that the details meet the requirements of the conditions.

The details are in accordance with the requirements of the London Plan and Policy A3 of the Camden Local Plan 2017.
