the Plans are unjust, massive, ugly and climate destroying.

the tower is far too tall and far too bulky

it will adversely affect local listed buildings such as St Georges Church, Bedford Square, and the British Museum.

The conservation areas of Covent Garden, Bloomsbury and Soho will suffer from its out of scale 74m height.

Putting a taller building on the site will set a precedent for more tall buildings in the neighborhood, for which Camden will then find it very hard to refuse permission.

The scheme intends to demolish the Travelodge tower and replace it with a brand new bigger office block. Demolition is contrary to the climate change policies of the UK. GLC and Camden, all of which advocate retrofitting. retrofit is possible.
