There is no plan for replacement planting, presumably because the Cemetery is still finalising its plans. None of the trees is assessed as being at a high risk of falling. Under these circumstances, it would be better to leave the trees where the risk is low, monolith those where the risk is moderate, and maintain habitat for bio-diversity. There has been a gradual attrition of trees in the cemetery. We would ask the Tree Officer (and indeed the Environment Officer) to talk to the Cemetery about how to best manage the trees and habitat while finalising the landscape plan.</p> <p>Louise Lewis Highgate Neighbourhood Forum</p> |
