Tree Bat boxes to be installed prior to first occupation. These will be no less than 3m above ground level and away from any neighbouring ledge to prevent local cats predated on bats using the boxes. A minimum of two Chillon Woodstone bat box(es) or similar boxes (Figure 1) will be hung on the trees at a minimum of 3m from ground level and face south/southwesterly. These boxes are known to be used by crevice and void dwelling species.

Tree Bird boxes to be installed prior to first occupation. Boxes to be ideally positioned facing east to take advantage of the early morning sun. All boxes should have a clear flight path to the entrance.



Owl boxes, (Figure 2), box to be at least 5 metres above ground level. Clean out the box every year, leaving a thin layer of pellets, new boxes should be lined with bark chippings.



Basic hole entrance box, (Figure 3), box to be at least 3 metres above ground level. 28mm diameter hole to attract great tits, tree sparrows and pied flycatchers

SCALE 1:100 @ A1



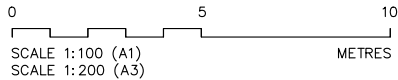
