				This is a nice example of a red brick Edwardian building with Portland stone and pink granite detailing of the piers. The existing shopfront, although not authentic, at least has a traditional setback central door configuration with panelled stall risers and it appears to be timber. The new proposal is for two separate doors either side of a very large central pane in an aluminium glazing system. The proposed "stall riser" is diminutive and the line of the riser does not line through the doors which have a mid height heavy panel quite unlike a traditional door for this type of shopfront. We object strongly to this proposal as outlined for the above reasons.
