The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** a certificate of lawfulness for the following reason:

## Reason(s) for Refusal

- The proposed outbuilding by reason of its scale and intended use, fails to be of a purpose incidental to the enjoyment of the dwellinghouse as such, contrary to Schedule 2, Part 1, Class E of The Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (England) Order 2015 (as amended).
- The proposed development would result in a breach of conditions 3 and 5 of planning permission 2021/0984/P dated 20/08/2011 (detail subsequently

approved on 29/03/2022 under planning reference: 2021/5768/P) which has been implemented on site, contrary to Article 3(4) and as such, is not permitted under Schedule 2, Part 1, Class E of The Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (England) Order 2015 (as amended).
