The 2 units are quite close together on a small wall and will inevitably cause disturbance to us. The owners have recently refurbished the property (I am unaware if they had planning permission for the extra rooms created) and we are already experiencing noise disturbance from their guests.

These units were installed several months ago without planning permission although not yet turned on.

We will also not be able to enjoy our garden if there is constant noise disturbance.

Sumatra Road is a residential street of terraced houses with the Charlotte Guest House being the only non residential property in the street and we regularly experience problems from their guests/ We therefore do not need any extra disturbances to contend with.
