I am an architect and have lived here since 1994.

I am writing to record my complete agreement with all the points/ objections to the proposals set out in Stuart Tappin's letter dated 21/10/23 -a further copy of which is attached- and to express my particular concern about the proposed positioning of the mechanical plant/ heat pumps on the roof. In my opinion any such plant on the roof should be kept to an absolute minimum and be strictly within the curtilage of the ventilation shafts and placed symmetrically to the Lift Motor Room (ie., placed centrally).

I also think that if it were possible that Camden also look to installing Solar Panels to reduce the dependence on imported gas for heating.
