1 Reasons for granting permission-

Condition 10(a) (window details): The Council's conservation officer has reviewed the submitted information to re-discharge part a and only the window details. Part a of condition 10 was previously discharged under reference 2022/5553/P and the applicant wishes to make minor adjustments to the window design only. It has been demonstrated that the proposed works would

not cause undue harm to the character and appearance of the host building or conservation area and therefore the condition can be discharged.

The planning and appeal history of the site has been taken into account when coming to this decision.

The submitted details are consistent with the general expectations of the approved scheme and are acceptable in all other respects.
