We have no objection to the general pruning in this garden but we regret the felling of two mature silver birches which add to the density of the growth in the front garden and, therefore to the character of this section of Highgate West Hill.

The trees appear somewhat aetiolated and may detract from the ecology of the immediate area around them. We can see advantages in opening up the front garden. However in view of the Mayor of London's commitment to increasing canopy and improving bio-diversity, if the trees are felled, suitable replacement trees should be planted.
