I would like to oppose strongly the planned felling of trees in front of 130 Greencroft Gardens (planning reference number 2023/4415/T).

My husband and I have just moved into the neighbouring house at 132, and one of the main reasons we chose this area is the lovely greenery. We also just had a baby boy born in early October. It would be such a loss if these trees were cut down now.

I understand that the roots of the trees may be contributing to minor cracking on the steps of a neighbouring building, but as we are in the South Hampstead conservation area the trees really should be preserved if at all possible, and as the insurer's report acknowledges, it is possible to fix the problem while preserving the trees. I hope the council will reject the application for the same reasons it rejected a similar application in 2021.
