I am the owner of the lower ground floor flat at 27 Primrose Gardens, NW3 4UJ. I wish to lodge an objection to the proposed rear extension to 25 Primrose Gardens on the following grounds:

- 1. There is no relevant precedent for the proposal.
- 2. The rhythm and continuity of the terrace form would be disrupted by the proposal. This is contrary to the Council's design policies.
- 3. There would be an adverse effect on the amenity of adjoining owners.
- 4. There would be an unacceptable impact upon my dwelling as a direct result of increased sense of enclosure.
- 5. Both daylight and sunlight reaching my dwelling would be seriously reduced.
- 6. The level of privacy presently afforded to me would be greatly reduced.
- 7. Peaceful enjoyment of my private garden would be adversely affected as a direct consequence of overlooking from the proposed terrace area.

In light of the above objections for consent for this proposal should be refused.
