I am registering my objection to the development of the area on the corner of Museum Street and High Holborn.

I object to demolition of the existing group of buildings because some of which are building are of historic interest. They add to the diversity of the area.

I object to the building of a structure much greater than the existing surrounding buildings. My greatest concern is if allowed to be constructed to its intended height specification it will set a precedent for any future submissions to receive permission. That height will slowly but surely engulfing all previously built blocks of flats, hotels and commercial buildings.

Centre point should retain its platform, being the landmark structure for this area.

No building should exceed the height of CentrePoint.

I have lived at Parnell House, Streatham Street, for 28 years. I know I am very lucky to live here. I appreciate the history of the area and understand the necessity for development.

That particular area has been left for a number of years now, I am not opposed to developing any area, renewal is important. Today's planning should always give full consideration to the environment, the need, we should not be demolishing buildings that with sustainable, purposeful planning could be brought to life again.

There are enough monstrous buildings in the area, some of which are not fully occupied.

This is the wrong building for the area. I strongly object to the intended development.
