I am writing to you as a resident stakeholder of the Primrose Hill community.

The existing temporary gate situation is a completely unsatisfactory state of affairs, and requires an immediate and permanent solution.

The existing gates are;

- flimsy, not fit for purpose, are constantly bent out of shape and damaged, particularly by late night recalcitrant revellers,
- unsightly and not in keeping with the heritage fence, detracting from the unique historic community attributes of the park,
- regularly an Occupational Health and Safety issue to both park users and parks staff (particularly given the aforementioned regular damage) , resulting in a significant ongoing liability issue which is untenable.
