IN CLOSE (SEE MAP): 1 x Golden Honey Locust (Gleditsia triacanthos 'Sunburst') (T286) - Prune from adjacent structure to clear lamp column by 1m.

- 1 x Norway Maple (Acer platanoides) (T287) Lift canopy to 3.5m over drive. Remove epicormic growth at 2m to southeast.
- 1 x Fastigiate Hornbeam (Carpinus betulus 'Fastigiata') (T288) Prune from adjacent structure to clear buildings by 1m. Lift canopy to 3.5m over drive.
- 1 x Saucer Magnolia (Magnolia x soulangeana) (T700) Prune from adjacent structure to clear building by 1m. Lift canopy to 3m over footpath and car parking, clearing access to no.42 front door.
- 1 x Sweet Gum (Liquidambar styraciflua) (T706) Lift canopy to 2m over drive/ car parking.
- 1 x Maidenhair (Gingo biloba) (T709) Lift canopy to 2.5m over car parking.
- 1 x Hornbeam (Carpinus betulus) (T710) Lift canopy to 5m over road. Prune from adjacent structure to clear building by 1.5m.
