FRONT GARDEN: 1 x Acer Palmatum (T1) - Lift crown all round to give 2m clearance.

1 x Fig (T2) - Thin crown by 20%, lightly reduce all around by approx. 1m. REAR GARDEN: 1 x Lime (T3) - Re-pollard as per previous practice.

1 x Pear (T4) - Fell as close as possible to ground level.

1 x Copper Beech - Reduce spindly top by 2m and re-shape lower parts.

1 x Laurel (T6) - Cut back to approx. 6 ft. to leave a bare framework.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 05 October 2023 and does not wish to object.
