having seen the proposed designs for the gates to primrose hill park, i am concerned that they are not at all in keeping with the heritage and relevant aesthetic of our beautiful area.

please could you ensure that the following guidelines are executed before any further progress.

- 1 The proposed gates would be aesthetically in keeping with the existing railings that surround the park and of a visual appearance that befits a grade 2 listed Metropolitan Open Space.
- 2 The proposed gates would be a significant improvement on the current wire barricades which are flimsy, subject to sustained vandalism and once broken can cause potential danger to people and dogs using the park.
- 3 The materials, construction and infrastructure of the proposed gates are of a high standard which befits a space that forms part of a Royal Park.
