The elder is leaning, large branches have broken off during the last 2 winters and the weight of the tree/tree roots has resulted in cracks appearing in the low level perimeter wall.

The Elder tree the work is proposed substantially overhangs the property I live in. Photographic proof can be provided on request.</p> <p>At no point over the past year have I been consulted on the proposed work to the Elder tree, nor have I been given a reason as to why the work needs to be completed, which is of great concern to me. There is a high probability that the proposed work to the elder tree could potentially cause damage to the property I live in. May I enquire what measures have been taken to ensure that damage to my property has been considered and what those measures are? It is imperative that I am notified of when the work is scheduled, prior to the work commencing, so that I can arrange to be at home whilst the works take place.</p> <p>In the event that any damage is caused I can be onsite and present. Should any damage occur, please advise what is the position for effecting repairs. This is of great concern to me as the works have been scheduled during winter and I do not wish to have delays or issues with a damaged roof, in light of the recent bad weather.</p> <p>on a separate note. I received the letter advising me of the works on Saturday 18th November. The date on the letter regarding the planned works was dated 30th October and gives the deadline of 21 days. Due to the letter being sent second class, I have only been advised of the works at the very last minute, this defeats the object of informing residents prior to the work being proposed and gives precious little time to reply. I will be making a formal complaint to the council following this.</p>
