Until recently Primrose Hill has been a place where one can enjoy an evening stroll, through without incident.

But that has now changed as 'invading' outsiders, mostly youngsters, mostly travelling long distances in response to SM rave invitations, come to party, all night, on the Hill without any regard to the residents living nearby.

As is to be expected with these kind of impromptu gatherings, drug dealers have started turning up in their cars offering cut-price drugs to anybody who walks past them and creating a nuisance. Loud music keeps the
