Here's condition 4 of 2019/6305/L, my emphasis:

Detailed drawings, or **samples of materials as appropriate**, in respect of the following, shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the local planning authority before the relevant part of the work is begun:

- a) Manufacturer's specification details of all facing materials (to be submitted to the Local Planning Authority) and samples of those materials (to be provided on site) or via high-resolution email photographs if site viewing is not possible). Samples of materials to be provided at a suitable size (eg. 1x1m);
- b) Typical details of new railings (including infills to existing railings) at a scale of 1:10, including materials, finish and method of fixing.
- c) Plan, elevation and section drawings of all new doors at a scale of 1:10 with typical moulding and architrave details at a scale of 1:1.
- d) Plan, elevation and section drawings, including jambs, head and cill, of all new window and door openings.
- e) Plan, elevation and section drawings of all new windows at a scale of 1:10 with typical glazing bar details at 1:1.
- f) Details of service runs for all new bathrooms/kitchens, demonstrating the relationship of new pipework with historic fabric.

Being from 2019, I think the high-res photos caveat is a covid clause.

Are you actually planning to build any walls with this brick, or is it only for spot repairs? If so, perhaps if someone actually held it against the existing brickwork and photographed it, I could see whether I can form an opinion remotely.

The usual procedure is for you to supply a sample panel on site next to the wall in question; I think that's what the condition stipulates. Otherwise I have no clue how closely the proposed brick resembles the existing house and, again, cannot discharge the condition.

The intention is for the brick to be used as infills and repairs as required to the existing fabric of the main house and the lodge (principally on the rear north elevation), as well as to the areas of masonry over cladding to the Annexe.


Brickwork salvaged from the limited demolitions will also be used in preference on the more sensitive south and east elevations, but it is noted that there is only going to be a very limited supply of these.






