Any replacement buildings on the site should be no higher then the existing buildings. The development will harm the Old Crown public house, 33 New Oxford Street and the Grade II listed buildings adjoining the site boundary at 43-45 New Oxford Street and 16 West Central Street. The Old Crown public house adjoins the site and was identified as a positive contributor in the Conservation Area Appraisal, along with 35-41 New Oxford Street. The pub has outdoor seating and function rooms on the upper floors and their business is likely to be impacted during construction of the scheme.
