1 Reasons for granting permission:

The details submitted for Condition 3 include details of brickwork with a large site panel sample (Petersen Kolumba K91 hand cast brick), Petersen's Manufacture data sheet which shows the mortar and acid wash look. Further details are submitted for the large windows to be installed, the plans show sections and elevations of the glazing, manufacturer datasheet with examples images.
