Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended) NOTIFICATION OF AN APPEAL

The Council has been notified of an appeal by Mr Matthew Finn and Ms Andriana Finn against the Council's enforcement notice, which has been made to the Planning Inspectorate. The appeal concerns property at:

Flat A 17 Nassington Road London NW3 2TX

and the breach of planning control alleged in the enforcement notice is: Installation of razor wire on the flat roof of the single-storey rear extension.

REASONS FOR ISSUING THIS NOTICE:

- a) The development has occurred within the last 4 years.
- b) The razor wire that has been installed on the flat roof of the rear extension fails to respect the residential nature of the property and, by its obtrusive and incongruous design, harms the character and appearance of the host building and this part of the South Hill Park Conservation Area. As such, the works are contrary to Policy D1 (Design) and Policy D2 (Heritage) of the Camden Local Plan 2017.

Grounds of Appeal

The appellant/s have appealed on grounds (a), (b), (c), (f), (g) as set out at Section 174(2) of the 1990 Act.

- a) That planning permission should be granted for what is alleged in the notice. (X)
- b) That the breach of control alleged in the enforcement notice has not occurred as a matter of fact (X)
- c) That there has not been a breach of planning control. (X)

d) That, at the time the enforcement notice w stated in the notice.	/as issued, it was too late to take enforce ()	ement action against the matters
(e) The notice was not properly served on ev	veryone with an interest in the land.	()
f) The steps required to comply with the required the objections.	uirements of the notice are excessive, ar (X)	nd lesser steps would overcome

The appeal is to be decided by an Inspector from the Planning Inspectorate on the basis of an exchange of **written statements** between the people who have made the appeal and the Council, followed by a site visit.
