Green Roof - Maintenance Schedule

Roof inspection

Sedum roof to be inspected twice a year in spring and autumn for weeds and seeds (carried by the wind) and unwanted vegetation removed manually. To encourage bio-diversity no chemical pesticides to be used. Any leaves blown into the gutters and drains to be removed.

Fertilization

Fertilise green roof twice a year in late April and early September.

Irrigation

Under very dry conditions the green roof to be irrigated.



85mm deep trays to promote healthy root system and drought tolerance 8 different varieties of Sedum.


