Dear Sirs

We refer to Applications 2019/3275/P and 2023/4104/P from 7 Haversham Place, London N6 6NG (No 7) and Applications 2022/0013/P and 2023/0043/P from 2 Haversham Place, London N6 6NG (No 2).

No 7 undertook a loft conversion and constructed two dormer windows with uPVC casement windows instead of timber sash windows and with slate cheeks rather than lead cheeks (neither of which are in accordance with the planning approval granted by Camden Council as per 2019/3275/P). We understand that No 7 intends to rectify the first of these issues (by installing timber sash windows) and has applied for retrospective approval for slate cheeks rather than lead cheeks (2023/4104/P) in respect of the second issue. There is a precedent with No 2 which also undertook a loft conversion; and constructed three dormer windows (with materials not in accordance with the planning approval granted as per 2022/0013/P); and applied for retrospective approval for slate cheeks rather than lead cheeks for their dormer windows (2023/0043/P) which was declined by Camden Council.

The purpose of this email is to request that Camden Council acts consistently in its planning approvals (specifically with respect to 2023/4104/P) for two reasons: a principle of fairness and the ability for people to know/understand what is acceptable in terms of future planning decisions.
