| | | | | I live above the current unit and proposed new unit in flat 187C and based on the current unit in place which has proved to exceed acceptable noise levels object to the new proposal. Given the current unit was installed without planning permission and any complaints have been dismissed and disregarded by the applicant and the one attempt to make the noise better (which was only after council involvement and about 12months of work from my neighbour) was entirely without technical know how I have no faith that the new revised plan would be any better. We have lived with this nuisance since 2021, which has caused one neighbour to move out due in sheer frustration and impact to her sleep, and we have finally got peace and quiet due to the enforcement issued so you can understand my trepidation that we could go back to square 1 with the excessive noise levels. Part of the acoustic report submitted by the applicant notes that the background noise continues into the evening, however they note 9pm when all noise complaint visits have been 12pm - 3am as this when the background noise abates and any excessive noise really is unreasonable at that time. In addition the report focuses on the noise level, but not the fact that it is an inconsistent noise which is more disruptive, nor what the human impact is of having that noise 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. It is truly hellish, and no report can demonstrate the actual impact of living around it. Due to the above I object to the application request. | | | |
