I wish to object strongly to this planning application for the reasons given by the Hampstead & Heath Society and also for 3 other reasons stated below:

1. I live at 21 Christchurch Hill, opposite the garden of 9 Gainsborough Gardens. I object to the proposed development of an oversized garden room, which I believe will be directly visible from Christchurch Hill and will change the appearance of this conservation area. I do not believe that such a large property requires this additional development. I note it is currently sited to be close to the Christchurch Hill end of the garden.
2. I have a significant medical condition, and hugely value the peace we currently have at night on this quiet one-way street. I note the applicant is placing their proposed heat pump at the Christchurch Hill end of their garden. Please can I request that if this is installed, it is placed closer to the house at 9 Gainsborough Gardens, so that any noise from this plant impacts the householder rather than us.
3. Christchurch Hill is a quiet and narrow one-way street. Please could this be taken account of during the construction process, ensuring lorries, deliveries and skips obey the one-way strictures.
