Heritage Statement

All Hallow's Hall 53 Courthope Road NW3 2LE

Site Information

The site is occupied by a three-level building known as 'All Hallows Hall.

The site is located immediately to the south-east and has historically been used in association with the Grade II listed (No. 1378658). All Hallows Church.


A small forecourt is positioned at the front of the wall, with external, gated staircases located at the front of either side of the building. Railings were partly in place at the front of the site, approximately 5-10 years ago.

The application building is in the Mansfield Conservation Area and identified as a Positive Contributor.

The as built changes are the following:

The proposal is erection of low height pillars on either side with metal railings, and a metal framed gate in the middle at the front boundary.
