1 Reasons for granting consent:

This approval of details application seeks to discharge conditions 4 (which requires detailed drawings of new doors and windows), 5 (which requires details of the York stone front step), and 7 (which requires details of the facing materials of the rear extension) to be submitted.

Detailed drawings of the new doors and windows, and material samples and product sheets of the York stone front step and the Portland stone and zinc on the rear extension have been submitted. These have been reviewed by the Council's Conservation team who raised no objection to the submitted details.

The full impact of the proposed development has already been assessed. The proposed details would not have a harmful impact on the appearance of the host buildings and streetscene, or on the character of the conservation area.
