PROPOSED ALTERATIONS AT 132 LEIGHTON ROAD LONDON NW5 2RG

HERITAGE STATEMENT

Significance of the Heritage asset affected

The proposal comprises of minor alterations to 132 Leighton Road—the erection of an infill extension for a WC at rear first floor level, the changing of a window in the flank wall of the lower ground floor cellar to a door, the replacement of the doors and windows to the lower ground floor rear with new double glazed colour coated aluminium and the erection of a bike store in the front garden. The house is a Victorian linked villa in the Kentish Town Conservation Area. The extension is of modest scale and the alterations are minor. The materials used will be appropriate for the Conservation Area—brick to match existing for the extension walls and a timber window.

Impact of proposal

The alterations are of a minor nature and the extension will have very little impact on the rear of the terrace of houses.

Contribution of the proposal

The proposal has been designed to relate and acknowledge the existing house.
