We received a letter this morning to each of 28 and 28a Park Village East to tell us that the Council had 'received a notification for proposed works to tree(s) located at the following address' then our address.

We have, in fact, been alerted to these proposed works by a kind neighbour who trawls the planning site and have commented but it would be good if you could send out letters straight after writing them, rather than leaving them lying around in the office before anyone remembers to put them in the post! If it is Royal Mail's fault, I apologise. In this case, perhaps you could give recipients a longer period in which to comment bearing in mind RM's tardiness.
