Dear Camden Council,

I am writing to express my objection regarding the unauthorized construction of a gazebo at Flat 5, 9-11 Belsize Grove. It has come to my attention that this structure was erected without the necessary planning permission, a matter of significant concern.

As a resident directly facing the location of the gazebo, the structure has caused a substantial visual intrusion and a significant invasion of my privacy. The gazebo's presence directly impacts the aesthetic view from my property and erodes the privacy due to its positioning.
