The applicant has failed to give proposals.

and

2) has applied to remove a section of important tree line.

The two cypresses form part of a long canopy chain that connects all along the Lancaster Grove and Eton Avenue internal border. This allows birds and squirrels to remain above ground for over 200m. Removing these trees would damage habitats and foraging patterns. They need to be replaced with other mature trees first, before applying to remove healthy trees.
