Please add this to the website - I couldn't find a link for comments:

I live in a neighbouring house, I wish to add to the comments of my wife and daughter (comment on 23 January).
The problem of blocking of light to our garden would be mostly resolved if the extension were reduced in size to 3m rather than 6m in length. This is because the sloping ground which would lead to an excessively high wall overshadowing our garden mainly starts about 3m from our houses.

There are 69 houses comprising the Meadowbank development and none of them have extensions of 6m length. It would be far more appropriate if this extension were 3m in length rather than the 6m being asked for. I understand that 3m was the maximum length for permitted development extensions under the old rules.
