I enclose an application by Transport for London (TfL) for planning permissions for the installation of Cycle Hire docking stations (26 docking stations maximum and a terminal, which will be placed on Albert Street in the London Borough of Camden.

The proposed Cycle Hire docking station replaces an existing Cycle Hire station on Parkway which has to be relocated due to bus lane changes.

The Cycle Hire scheme is now a familiar public transport mode which allows people to hire a cycle from a docking station and return it to either the same or another docking station. It also encourages active travel, offers a sustainable and low emission form of transport and provides users with the fastest option for many short journeys.
