The design is of a high and traditional standard entirely in keeping, reflecting a type of extension popular in some of London's most attractive and even historic streets. The extra floor, being well set back, would scarcely be visible from street level. Even in the event that passers-by strained to see it, such a design would arguably enhance the crescent. Camden is desperate for more space to house its vibrant community, and a problem frequently cited by planners is that London is low density compared to cities such as Paris because it does so little to build upwards. We, along with our other neighbours, as I understand it, would be open to building identical extensions which, aesthetically, would provide pleasing symmetry. However, our motivation in writing this supportive comment is entirely to help a growing family gain the space it needs. No reasonable neighbour should oppose a plan if it does no harm to them nor to the architectural integrity of the building.
