

# Billy Waters site plan and plaque position

The plaque will be positioned on the 7<sup>th</sup> of 13 horizontal columns (i.e. middle column) that make up the exterior wall frontage of Parnell House (Dyott Street side). Each of the 13 columns are made 12 smaller vertical columns which complete the brickwork exterior of Parnell House. The plaque will be installed between the 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> vertical column to give an aesthetic perfect position for the plaque on Parnell House

- Slide 2 shows position of the plaque viewed facing south from Great Russell Street, towards the junction Streatham Street (and Bainbridge Street)
- Slide 3 and 4 shows position of the plaque viewed facing north from Great Russell Street (and Bainbridge Street), towards Great Russell Street
- Slide 5 shows the position of the plaque as if viewed directly facing it on Dyott Street
- Slide 6 shows the position of the plaque as if viewed underneath it as if looking towards the top of Parnell House
- Slide 7 shows wording of the plaque. NB: The word premier will be replaced by Camden Council
- Slide 8 and 9 shows site plan position of the plaque using Ordnance survey Maps at scale 1:250 and 1:500 respectively
