I am an 87 year old lady who is mostly bed bound (my son is helping me with this objection). The proposed extension will severely block sunlight from my bedroom and any window placed there will have a direct view into my bedroom from only a few feet away. This would essentially completely end any privacy I have in my own bedroom. The noise and disturbance of any construction will also have a very negative impact on my health and well being. When I moved into my house in the late seventies I planted a tree in the front of my house in the corner next to 11 Perrins lane side wall. This tree is now mature and very beautiful and is a integral part of my home. Any scaffolding erected to access construction will severely damage and quite probably kill the tree. This would be heartbreaking as it is a very lovely tree indeed. Another consideration is that my carer parks his car in my space in front of my house (next to the tree). I have difficulty walking and use a wheel chair. The close proximity of the car is critical to me at all times. Having the car outside my house actually saved my life as it enabled my carer to get me to hospital almost immediately when i had a stroke. Again any scaffolding would preclude the car being able to park there.
