IN GROUNDS (SEE REPORT): 1 x Elm (T36), 1 x Holly (T9), 2 x Rowans (T20 & T30) & 2 x Sycamores (T25 & T26) & Group of dying trees (G7) - Fell to ground level.

2 x Birches (T21 & T22) - Fell to ground level & treat stump.

1 x Elm (T37) - Reduce by 3m - 4m.

1 x Lime (T31) - Reduce canopy by 3m - 4m & spread by 2m - 2.5m

Group of Elms (G35) - Reduce height by 2m - 3m.

- 1 x Raywood Ash (T4) Reduce by 3m 4m & width by 2m 2.5m.
- 1 x Eucalyptus (T14) Reduce height 4m 5m & balance.
- 1 x Sycamore (T24) Reduce height by 2m 3m.
- 1 x Prunus (T28) Lift canopy over road by up to 3m.
- 1 x Sycamore (T15) Reduce regrowth back to previous points.
- 1 x Pear (T16) Reduce by 1m 2m & spread by 0.5m.
- 1 x Sycamore (T18) Reduce regrowth back to previous points.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 09 December 2023 and does not wish to object.
