Summary of consultation responses:	The Council received one objection to the notification as follows:  I object to removing T5 the Lombardy Poplar, a slow-growing, shallow-rooted tree, and very beautifull. T5 adds to the beauty of rear aspects of neighbouring properties on Belsize Grove and Howitt Road.

Assessment
The notification alleges that the poplar is implicated in clay shrinkage subsidence occurring at an adjacent property. The evidence submitted is considered sufficient to demonstrate that, on the balance of probability, the tree is contributing to subsidence at the property.
The lime has low visibility from a public place, it is not a particularly large or noteworthy example of its species and has poor form. While evidence of the limes involvement in subsidence at the property is inconclusive, the allegations and the trees proximity to the damage further undermine the case for bringing this tree under the protection of a TPO.
It would not be expedient to bring these trees under the protection of a tree preservation order.
