- Following completion of the erection of protective fencing as deemed appropriate for the level of site works to ensure it is constructed to the correct specification at the required proximity to ensure the healthy retention of the trees. Date and time to be confirmed.
- Installation of the ground protection as deemed appropriate for the level of site works to ensure it is installed to the correct specification. **Date and time to be confirmed.**
