This trend, established by the Rashford centre replacement at 11 storeys, encourages ever larger heights in this conservation area. A rush to build such blocks changes the character of Chalk Farm but will also place the sightlines of Hampstead Heath and Primrose Hill under pressure. Such approvals will lead to similar requests in neighbouring Kentish Town sites peppering a cohesive community with islands of blocks breaking the homogeneity and character of the area.
